Smaller resorts are also added and marked as dots. With the data from skiresort.info the map lists for each of the 413 ski resorts, divided by difficulty, blue, red, and black slope kilometers, as well as the minimum and maximum height of each resort.

Apart from the ski areas the state borders, the most important waters, roads and passes, and mountains and cities help to orientate oneself on the map.

The new map of the 413 ski resorts of Austria will be available on 15th Novemer for 30 € on www.marmotamaps.com and in selected shops.
